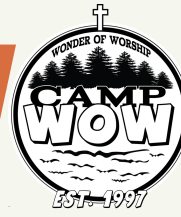

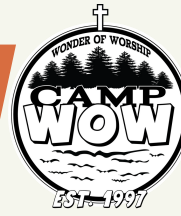

• FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS •

- *Wait... what is Camp Wow?!*

Camp Wow is an overnight summer camp for middle schoolers, currently in 6th-8th grade. It is run by high school counselors who apply, interview, and are selected for this role. They go through MANY trainings in order to be a successful counselor. There are many parishes involved in Camp Wow, and the Youth Ministers spend ALL year planning this camp to make it incredible for students.

- *What do the campers do?*

Middle schoolers will get to do activities such as low ropes, archery, zipline, teambuilding, swimming, Wacky Olympics and more! There will also be praise and worship, Adoration, Mass, and small group times. They will hear many talks by the high school counselors, and they will have the opportunity to grow in their faith surrounded by others in a similar place in life.

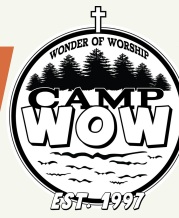
- *How do the campers get there?*

Campers will take a bus to Timber-lee. Parents only need to get campers to the bus location assigned to their parish. (Our parish's bus location last year was Sycamore.) There is also the possibility of campers carpooling from our parish to the bus location.

- *What Parishes are involved, and will there be adults present?*

Camp Wow consists of St. Mary's-Sycamore, St. Mary's-Huntley, St. Gall-Elburn, St. Thomas the Apostle-Crystal Lake, St. John the Baptist-Somonauk, Holy Family-Rockford, St. Mary's-Dekalb, Christ the Teacher-Dekalb, and St. Margaret Mary-Algonquin. Youth Ministers from these parishes will be there the whole time!

• FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS •

- *What is the cost to attend?*

\$350/camper. A \$75 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration with the balance due At the parent meeting - date TBD. The actual cost to run this camp is much more, but the parishes feel it's important to keep the fees as low as possible!

- *What does the cost include?*

The cost of camp includes activities, lodging, meals and snacks, and transportation between the bus location and Lutherdale. Campers may bring spending money (\$10-\$20) to spend at the Camp Store, but this is optional.

- *Is financial assistance available?*

Yes! We never want a student to miss out on camp because of the cost. Scholarship are available! Contact your youth minister for details.

- *How do I register?*

Complete the form at <https://www.jotform.com/233187897437170> and submit your \$75 deposit to the main office, or in the collection basket in an envelope marked "Veronica/Camp Wow registration".

- *When does registration end?*

Each parish has a reserved number of spots until March 15th. Unfilled spot will be release to all parishes on March 15, so early registration is highly encouraged! Registration closes May 1st.
