

St. Thomas Aquinas is one of my favorite saints. We normally celebrate his Memorial on January 28th, but this year we do not because the 28th is the 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Since we will miss that Memorial, I would like to offer you one of my favorite prayers

that is attributed to him:

"Grant, o merciful God, that I may ardently desire, prudently examine, truthfully acknowledge, and perfectly accomplish what is pleasing to Thee for the praise and glory of Thy name. Amen."
