### Hope Haven Meal Making Service Project

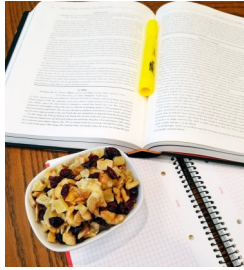
Join us at 4:30pm on Thursday, February 20th in the Newman Kitchen! All college students are invited! The basic schedule is as follows:
